

**CONSTITUTION**

**PACIFIC NORTHWEST CLEAN WATER ASSOCIATION**

**ARTICLE I**

PURPOSE:

The object of this organization is to provide regular and frequent meetings for all persons actively working in the field of wastewater treatment for the advancement of the fundamental and practical knowledge concerning the nature, collection, treatment, and disposal of wastewater and industrial wastes, and the design, construction, operation, and the management of wastewater works through the inter-change between members of the Section and members of the Association and others of experience, information and opinion.

**ARTICLE II**

GEOGRAPHICAL AREA:

This Section shall derive its active membership from those wastewater treatment works located in Bannock, Bear Lake, Bingham, Blaine, Bonneville, Butte, Camas, Caribou, Cassia, Clark, Custer, Franklin, Fremont, Gooding, Jefferson, Jerome, Lemhi, Lincoln, Madison, Minidoka, Oneida, Power, Teton, and Twin Falls counties of Idaho. This area is to be known as the Southeast Idaho Section.

**ARTICLE III**

MEMBERSHIP:

Any person or persons actively engaged in operating, maintaining, or supervising a wastewater or industrial wastes treatment plant or stabilization ponds within the area as set forth in ARTICLE II, shall be eligible to become an active member. There shall be no geographical boundaries for a corporate member.

#### **ARTICLE IV**

##### **OFFICERS:**

Ten officers shall constitute the Board of Directors of this Section. They shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary/Treasurer, Secretary/Treasurer Elect and six Area Directors.

#### **ARTICLE V**

##### **BOARD MEMBERS:**

The Board of Directors shall have the authority to conduct all business pertaining to the activities of this Section. They shall endeavor to carry out the desires of the majority of the Members as expressed by vote in any regular business meeting.

#### **ARTICLE VI**

##### **RULES AND LAWS:**

Roberts Rules of Order Revised shall govern the organization in all cases to which they PNCWA

#### **ARTICLE VII**

##### **AMENDMENTS:**

Amendments to the Constitution may be made on a two-thirds vote of the members present. Any proposed amendment shall be written and introduced at a regular Section Meeting and the vote must be taken at the following regular meeting. All amendments shall be subject to final approval by the Executive Committee of the Pacific Northwest Clean Water Association.
